



## Southern EP/MEP Open House 2018

Activity	Skit Competition
Hosted by	Phuketwittayalai School
Level	Each School can choose only ONE level 1. Lower Secondary Level (M.1-3) 2. Combined level (M.1-6)
Competitors	5 Students per one School

### 1. Objectives

1. To encourage students to step out of their comfort zone
2. To improve confidence in speaking and pronunciation as well as emphasizing their acting skills and abilities.

### 2. Competition rules

1. 5 actors including the narrator.
2. Fun, humorous and entertaining.
3. The participants must choose their own story.
4. 5 copies of the script must be handed to the judges before the competition begins.
5. Participating teams pick up numbers in order to arrange the order of presentation.
6. No microphones and sound-effects allowed. Background music is permitted (There are no electric devices provided.)
7. Duration of performance: 5 minute stage preparation and 10 minute skit performance.

### 3. Criteria ( 100 marks )

#### 3.1 Acting (30 marks)

- Characterization - Were the characters believable and maintained throughout the skit?
- Use the voice, energy level - Did the actors use projection, intonation and tone?
- Movement, gesture - Were the action and body language appropriate for the character?
- Use of stage space - Did the actors use the space effectively?

#### 3.2 Language skills (30 marks)

- Use of language – Were the words heard and understood by the audience?
- Fluency – Did the actors speak smoothly and confidently?
- Accuracy – Were the students speaking the words correctly?
- Pronunciation – Did the students pronounce the words clearly?

#### 3.3 Production (30 marks)

- Method of performance – Was the story clear and maintained throughout the skit?
- Orchestration (grouping) – How well did everything work to create the overall performance?
- Strength of ensemble – Did the actors work well together?
- Adherence to time limit – Was the skit within 10 minute time limit?
- Moral – Was the message clear?

#### 3.4 Stage Presentation (10 marks)

- Costumes – Were the costumes appropriate for the character?

- Props and performance craft - Were the props and set appropriate for the skit?

#### 4. Judging

80 – 100 marks = Gold Medal

70 – 79 marks = Silver Medal

60 – 69 marks = Bronze Medal

50 – 59 marks = highly commended
