Level	Level 2 ( Grade 4-6)
Competitors	One Student per one School

### The level of competitor

- Level 2 : Prathom 4-6

### Type and number of competitor

- 1 student per level from each school.

### Topic

- Level 2 : Prathom (P.4 – P.6) ; My school, My hobby, The environment

### Time

- Level 2 : Prathom (P.4 – P.6) 3 – 4 minutes

(A 30 second grace period is allowed. Contestants who exceed the given grace period will be penalized with a point (1) deduction.)

### Rules of the Competition

- Contestants must register first before the contest proper.
- After registration, contestants will draw their respective slots.
- Contestants who come late during the drawing of slots will be the last speaker
- Contestants who come late thirty minutes after the competition begins will be forfeited.

- All the contestants will wait for their turn in a room provided, for preparation purposes.
- A room will be provided for contestants as their preparatory room.
- Contestants are given two chances to pick their topic and must choose only one of the topics being picked.
- Materials and scripts are not allowed

Taking of pictures, using of cellular phones and coaching are strictly prohibited.

- When the contestant delivers his/her speech, audience are not allowed to go in and out of the contest venue.

Criteria : 100 marks

Content 35 marks

- Accuracy and Consistency 15 marks
- Form and Organization of speech 10 marks
- Creativity 10 marks



Language competence and fluency 45 marks

- Using language appropriately according to their level concerning with vocabulary and structure 15 marks
- Pronunciation, stress, intonation, rhythm, pausing and pace 20 marks
- Tone 10 marks

Presentation 10 marks

- Able to make the audience understand the content of the speech 10 marks
- Time 10 marks
- Total 100 marks

Judging

- 80 – 100 points = Gold medal
- 70 – 79 points = Silver medal
- 60 – 69 points = Bronze medal

50 – 59 points = Highly commended
